Hands-on Gas & Electric Furnaces and Boilers

Two Sessions: October 1-2 or October 3-4, 2012 Chestnut Ridge Resort, Blairsville, PA

This seminar is all-about furnaces: how they work, how to trouble-shoot problems and the "fine art" of maintaining them. As part of the "hands-on" experience, attendees will be shown how to test furnace components. They will gain skills required to make repairs and perform preventative maintenance.

Proper safety procedures will be reviewed, and live electric currents used to demonstrate how to test electrical components. The seminar will cover the use a digital multi-meter. Class members will practice its use, testing both gas and electrical components, to assure that they know exactly how to use it when they return to their agencies.

The afternoon session on the second day will be devoted to boiler operation and maintenance.

All participants will receive a workbook that details how to perform gas and electric furnace preventive maintenance, trouble shoot and make minor repairs, which can be used as a handy reference when on the job.

The seminar will be conducted by Training Services Association trainer LW Brittian who designed these seminars and has taught them for several years for TSA, colleges, universities and national training organizations. Previously, he was a mechanical and electrical contractor, electrical foreman, and HVAC department manager for a university. He is a certified proctor for the 608 EPA certification exam through the Refrigeration Engineers Society.
